Catalog Description:

Experience in an approved work activity under supervision of worksite supervisor and faculty member or program manager. Work activity may be paid or unpaid and must be related to a student's learning or occupational objectives. Requirement for one credit is 180 hours of approved work. Students may earn up to three credits in one semester. 180 hours per semester.

Course Outcome(s):

Apply specific skills in dance or dance enterprise appropriate to the field experience placement, as specified in an individualized learning contract.

Objective(s):

- 1. Develop written goals as part of the Field Experience Training Plan.
- 2. Participate in structured projects in the workplace.
- 3. Utilize appropriate business communication skills.
- 4. Identify and meet employer/customer expectations in the workplace.
- 5. Review and complete the written journal detailing professional experiences.
- 6. Complete assignments as directed by employer.

Methods of Evaluation:

- 1. Assessment of completed required hours as recorded in a log and verified by employer.
- 2. Evaluation of completed goals developed in Field Experience Training Plan.
- 3. Written journal detailing the major professional and technical experiences encountered.
- 4. Site supervisor evaluation.
- 5. Submission of all forms completed as required by the department.

Course Content Outline:

- 1. Supervised work experience. The student will follow the "Individual Field Experience Training Plan" under the direction of the employer/site supervisor. 12-36 clock hours per week are spent gaining practical hands-on work experience developing skills. The program manager and/or faculty member must approve student work experience sites.
- 2. Orientation to the organization/institution/agency.
