Develop an effective career plan via: reflection on self-awareness/discovery activities, completion and interpretation of career assessments and inventories, engagement in career experience activities, and exposure to occupational and career resources.

Objective(s):

- 1. Reflect on the results and characteristics identified by various career assessment and inventory tools to assist in the development of an effective career plan.
- 2. Investigate occupations compatible with individual values, goals, interests, personality, skills, and needs.
- 3. Understand and apply informed career decision-making concepts.
- 4. Explore and apply concepts of leisure time.
- 5. Examine major occupational information sources and be able to identify labor market trends (local and national).
- 6. Utilize online career research tools to access occupational information including: academic majors, salary calculators, employment outlook, higher education institutions, and additional occupational resources.
- 7. Complete an in-person/telephone interview or job shadowing experience related to an occupation of interest to enhance the crystallization process.
- 8. Conduct a classroom presentation on the experience and discoveries made during the informational interview/job shadowing experience.
- 9. Provide a written summary of the informational interview/job shadowing experience.
- 10. Utilize a life-line activity to reflect and share life experiences that have influenced their past and present academic and career decisions

- 11. Analyze components of making an informed career choice.
- 12. Identify personal factors that lead to job satisfaction.
- 13. Research, assess, and synthesize occupational information.
- 14. Create an activated and locked academic plan in Degree Works if class is to be used to fulfill the College's FYE requirement (GEN 1070).
